Recommendations of the International Federation of Rottweiler Friends (IFR) on Selection Criteria

The IFR recommends the following procedures and their clarification in official breeding regulations:

- 1. Mandatory minimum age for breeding animals of 20 months
- 2. Mandatory stop of breeding with bitches at the age of nine years
- 3. Mandatory interruption of breeding with bitches after a litter for a defined time
- 4. Mandatory breeding-related conformation assessment that is not carried out at a show
- 5. Mandatory examination for HD
- 6. Mandatory examination for ED
- 7. Mandatory FCI-BH/VT trial
- 8. Mandatory testing of social behaviour
- 9. Mandatory testing of action behaviour (based on IGP; where this is not possible, with another method)
- 10. Mandatory limitation of inbreeding
- 11. Breeding ban for bitches with two caesarean sections
- 12. Mandatory genetic testing for JLPP
- 13. Recommendation of genetic testing for LEMP and gaining experience with it
- 14. Recommendation of genetic testing for NAD and gaining experience with it
- 15. Support research into cancer and heart diseases
